

Routine Surgery Pricing Last Updated 3/24/2023 (Subject to Change Without Notice)

All Pets must be up to date (within 1 calendar year) on the following Vaccinations to be in the hospital for surgery, If we have not vaccinated your dog or cat for all of these vaccinations they will be given on the day of surgery for an additional fee. If you pet received any vaccinations form another clinic, those records need to be Texted to 254-803-3400 or emailed to records@marlinvetclinic.com at least 48 hours prior to their surgery date.

Dogs are Required to have: Rabies, Distemper/Parvo, Lepto, Bordetella, Influenza

Cats are Required to Have: Rabies, FVRCP, Leukemia

The Cost of Complete Series Given at the time of Surgery for Dogs is \$150 and for Cats is \$120 "Getting a shot" from xyz store is not proper vaccination and will not be an acceptable form of proof of vaccination; vaccinations must have been completed in a veterinary clinic.

Any Pet that Needs Extractions will Need to Schedule an Appointment to come in for an estimate, the cost of the Exam is \$55-70 and will be deducted from the Surgery Price if Dental is completed within 30 days.

Pre-Op Instructions for All Surgeries

Have your pet at the clinic between 8:15 and 8:30 am the day of their scheduled appointment, they will be ready to go home the same afternoon between 3:00 and 4:30 pm the majority of the time, should they need to stay overnight someone will contact you from the office. No Food After 10pm the Night Before Surgery, pets can continue to have water

Post-Op Instructions for All Surgeries

All pets will need to be kept confined for 7-10 days after surgery, this means no running and no jumping, leash walks only. Do not let them lick the surgical site and No bathes or water play for 7-10 days. Each surgery will receive additional detailed Post-Op instructions at discharge related to their specific surgery.

All other Surgical Procedures will require an Exam for Proper Estimate to be Given. We preform several other types of surgery included but not limited to Mass Removals, Orthopedic Surgery, Cherry Eye, Hematoma Repair, Wound Care, ETC
